



## Viewing the study results

Students are matriculated to a specific version of a study programme that consists of courses that are either compulsory or electives. The aim of studies is to get a passing grade in all compulsory courses and the selected electives. A study programme might have a portion allocated for extra curricular courses - these are all the courses that are not listed in the study programme. In addition to exams and pass-fail assessments, there can be interim assessments (e.g tests) during the course. Lecturer enters the exam and assessment results into ÕIS withing 10 working days counting from the exam or assessment.

### Interim assessment results:

2. An overview of interim assessment results is displayed, including:
  - a. All interim assessments planned for the course and their individual results
  - b. Sum of results
  - c. Overview of interim assessments already passed and not yet passed.
  - d. An average of the results.
  - e. Comment by the lecturer

  - which courses are still required to pass.
