

Test takers must present the EU digital COVID certificate which proves that the test taker

- has been vaccinated (with COVID-19 vaccine approved for the entire EU)
- has given a negative covid-19 test (SARS-CoV-2 antigen-RTD test must be performed up to 48 hours before the visit; SARS-CoV-2 RT-PCR test must be performed up to 72 hours before the visit)
- has recovered from covid-19 (proof is valid for 180 days from a positive test)

Certificate can be presented on the test day either on your smart device or on paper.

Test taker may also provide a negative rapid test certificate. In that case test taker must organize their own testing at a health care service provider or a holder of an activity license for a general pharmacy. Rapid test can be taken maximum of 48 hours before the exam.

If you have taken paid test in a place that uses SYNLAB, then you might need to generate the certificate through minu.synlab.ee or through the TESTI app, which you can download from testi.me. Inform the covid-19 test provider that you need a certificate.

Please check that your certificate is valid a day before the exam day on the website kontroll.digilugu.ee, so you can contact your covid-19 test provider in case there is a problem. Candidates, whose certificate shows invalid when scanning QR-code, will not be allowed to take the test.
