Christopher Stone is a Reader in Interpreting and Translation based at the University of Wolverhampton. He has engaged in translation and interpreting research on prosody, pragmatics, and multimodality in relation to interpreting and translation decisions; interpreting aptitude; and explored the history both archival and in living memory of deaf ghostwriting, language brokering, and interpreting. Currently he is funded by the AHRC to explore the delay in access for deaf victims of domestic violence, and by the ESRC (with colleagues in Berlin - Prof Rathmann, and Toulouse - Prof Segouat) to explore the current state of the art of deaf interpreters, mediators and translators. He is the current President of the World Association of Sign Language Interpreters.
